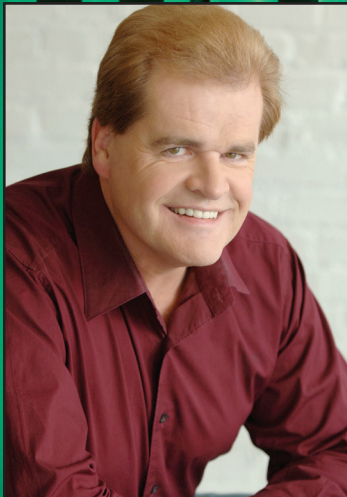
THANK YOU BROTHER COFFMAN
