VALLEY OF HARRISBURG SPRING REUNION SATURDAY MAY 22, 2021



REFLECTING THE BEST OF YOU

THURSDAY NIGHT AT THE RITE, a series of bi-weekly degree videos, are hosted on alternating Thursday evenings. The schedule is available on the Supreme Council Website and in our Valley of Harrisburg Facebook Group. These video presentations offer us an opportunity to do something we cannot easily do at our reunions; and that is to reflect on what we have seen and heard.

The Valley of Harrisburg Reflection Team was formed in 2019 to create a method and opportunity to reflect following ONE degree during a Reunion. Being limited to just one degree, the intent was to show that the process of true reflection can help members learn so much more about the degrees and themselves, and that they can do it on their own, as well. Clearly the reflection periods have helped participants understand the degrees and how the core values of the Scottish Rite really relate to us in our daily lives. The team has led discussions of the 4th, 17th, 23rd, 24th and 27th degrees, and are preparing to lead reflection periods after EVERY video presented by the Supreme Council.

The purpose of reflection has been very carefully studied as a legitimate and important aid to learning and comprehension. For those who are interested in the science behind it, look up Fink's Taxonomy of Significant Learning. This was the subject of Bro. Michael Moran's research paper to graduate from the Hauts Grades Academy—the important educational program of the Scottish Rite. Bro. Moran's paper is available on the Supreme Council website. He works with the Reflection Team to make sure that they are prepared with questions that will elicit responses showing growth, learning and understanding of the degrees. While the reflection periods are going on, Bro. Moran is tracking the responses and making sure that the team is leading a valuable reflection period. Following each reflection a two-minute survey is taken to gather data for Bro. Moran's follow up to his research paper—proof that his theories are workable and essential to quality understanding of the Scottish Rite Degrees.

We are thankful to Bro. Moran for his leadership, and for the other members of the Reflection Team who are facilitating the discussions. They are Mark Mattern, TPM, Charlie Goetz, Arthur Dinger, Richard Wenner, William Britton, Matthew Randolph and Tom Labagh.

2021 Abbott Scholarship Program

One of Freemasonry's fundamental principles is a belief in the importance of the educated mind. Freedom, understanding, and brotherhood are dependent upon our ability to reason effectively. That is why the Masonic fraternity, and Scottish Rite in particular, have long been committed to fostering the value of education. The Abbott Scholarships began with a portion of the legacy of the late Leon M. Abbott, 33°, Sovereign Grand Commander from 1921-1932. Each year, more than 300 scholarships are awarded to eligible and deserving students attending accredited colleges, universities, and specialty schools.

The Abbott Scholarship Program provides financial support for the continuing undergraduate and graduate education of Scottish Rite Masons, young men and women from Scottish Rite families, and Masonic-related youth groups.

Eligibility Requirements

Those meeting any of the following criteria are eligible to apply for the 2021 Abbott Scholarship program:

- A Scottish Rite Mason of the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction who is in good standing.
- A student related (by blood or legal means) to a current or deceased member of the Scottish Rite in the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction.

A member of a Masonicly sponsored youth group located within the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction (ex - DeMolay International, Job's Daughters, Order of Rainbow for Girls)

To be considered for an Abbott Scholarship, applicants must meet one of the following qualifications (please note that local Valleys may have more strict GPA requirements):

• A high school senior, currently accepted at an accredited trade school who has attained a minimum grade point average of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale.

A high school senior, undergraduate, or graduate student currently enrolled at an accredited college or university.
